Agreement between Indonesia and Spain

The Delegations of Indonesia and Spain at the V GATT Tariff Conference agree that their Governments will grant reciprocally the General most-favoured nation treatment under the rules of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade. Therefore, according to the Article I of the General Agreement any advantage granted by Indonesia to any other country will be extended to Spain and any advantage granted by Spain to any other country will be extended to Indonesia.


The Executive GATT Secretariat will be informed of this agreement and a copy of it will be forwarded to him.
