The Generation of Jouries recalls for the objective of the Kennedy Round of Frede Megetiations is the liber-livetion and expression of trade.

2. It also recells the finiterial Resolution of 5th Fry. 1964, which states that the contribution of the lass-developed countries to the overall objective of trade liberalization should be considered in the light of the development and trade needs of these countries; and that the industriclised countries cannot expect to receive reciprocity from the lessdeveloped countries.

5. In purchance of this, the Government of Jannies is propared to make its contributions to the overall objective of the trade negotiations in the following torms:-

(i) Consistent with her trade and develop out needs, Janeica is ready to offer the binding or lowering of her tariffs on certain industrial items. However, due to the fact that not all the offers of the developed countries on agricultural concessions have yet been tabled, all facts that one is unable to table her our offer list until she can assess the over-all trade benefits which are likely to accrue to Janaice from all the offers of the industrial countries on agricultural trade which is of such importance to Janaice's national economy.

(11) The Jennice offer list when tabled will also include conditional offers on the reduction or elimination of preferential margins on certain items of the Jennican teriff subject to consultations with the Commonwealth countries reflected. (412) . Government of Jaurier vision to strong englation of the contribution to tariff reductions has to trie into accornt. to vory important factors, neuclas first What, as a result of the linear outs, Jermion's morgin of preferences in developed Concorrection countries will be reduced or olirinated. Second that the offers of direct teriff reductions muct be seen in the light of the fact that Jamaice is a low teriff country with one of the sullest incidences of custome duties of the less developed countries. This is due to the fact that Janaica's custors tawiff has not yet been revised after the country became independent.

(iv) An part of Jancica's contributions to the objectives of the Xennedy Round of trade negotiations, the Government of Jancica. declares furthermore its intention to enter into negotiations with other loss developed countries regarding measures designed to o:pend trade between thermolves.

4. The Government of Jension wichos to reitorate its keen interest in the full success of the Kennedy Round nogotiations. It is hoped that this will be a milestone on the road to better and more liberal international trading conditions for less developed countries which depend so much on increased export earnings for the execution of their development programe. 
