NEGOTIATIONS: CZECHOSLOVAKIA - NORWAY.

We have to inform you that following upon informal discussions between the delegations of Norway and Czechoslovakia it has been mutually agreed that there is no basis for further negotiations between the two countries at the present session in view of the fact that the request list put forward by the Government of Czechoslovakia to the Government of Norway has been withdrawn.

The two delegations have agreed to rebind the existing schedules XIV and X in respect of those items directly negotiated between Norway and Czechoslovakia at previous tariff negotiations.
