


Share of Aid for Trade disbursements per region, 2020




AFRICA and ASIA remain the largest beneficiaries of Aid for Trade

AFRICA received 38% of total Aid for Trade disbursements, followed by ASIA (35%), AMERICA (10%), EUROPE (6%) and OCEANIA (1%)




### Infographic 1.2. Aid for Trade per category and by income group

# AID FOR TRADE IMPACT




**27.1%** of Aid for Trade projects contributed to **SDG 2** (Zero Hunger) through their contribution to improving food and agriculture production and distribution

Another 16.5% contributed to SDG 7 (Affordable and Clean Energy), 14.3% to SDG 9 (Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure) and 10.6% to SDG 8 (Decent Work and economic Growth)

SDG 7 represented 24.9% of total Aid for Trade disbursements, followed by SDG 9 (17.6%) and SDG 8 (16.4%), reflecting the higher cost of infrastructure projects
