1 ARTICLE XIII OF THE MARRAKESH AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING THE WORLD TRADE ORGANIZATION

1.1 Text of Article XIII

Article XIII

Non-Application of Multilateral Trade Agreements between Particular Members

1. This Agreement and the Multilateral Trade Agreements in Annexes 1 and 2 shall not apply as between any Member and any other Member if either of the Members, at the time either becomes a Member, does not consent to such application.

2. Paragraph 1 may be invoked between original Members of the WTO which were contracting parties to GATT 1947 only where Article XXXV of that Agreement had been invoked earlier and was effective as between those contracting parties at the time of entry into force for them of this Agreement.

3. Paragraph 1 shall apply between a Member and another Member which has acceded under Article XII only if the Member not consenting to the application has so notified the Ministerial Conference before the approval of the agreement on the terms of accession by the Ministerial Conference.

4. The Ministerial Conference may review the operation of this Article in particular cases at the request of any Member and make appropriate recommendations.

5. Non-application of a Plurilateral Trade Agreement between parties to that Agreement shall be governed by the provisions of that Agreement.

1.2 Invocations of Article XIII

1. As regards the practice of the non-application of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade 1947 (GATT 1947), see the document on Article XXXV of the GATT 1947 (GATT Analytical Index, pages 1031-1038).

2. Article XIII of the Marrakesh Agreement Establishing the World Trade Organization (WTO Agreement) has been invoked on 12 instances so far. Ten invocations were subsequently withdrawn, and two remain in force:

3. In addition, in April 2021, the following communication from Morocco was circulated to Members:

Reference is hereby made to communication L/6192 of 19 June 1987, in which the Government of Morocco notified its intention to invoke Article XXXV of the GATT in respect of Israel and South Africa, and communication L/7498 of 30 June 1994, in which it withdrew the invocation of this provision in respect of South Africa.

Insofar as communication L/6192 is considered to have remained in effect in respect of Israel, the Kingdom of Morocco hereby notifies that it is withdrawing the invocation of Article XXXV of the GATT in respect of Israel as of 20 April 2021. The Kingdom of Morocco thus consents to the application of the WTO Agreement between the Kingdom of Morocco and Israel.
