On the basis of Article 28 paragraph 4, Article 29 paragraph 5, Article 30 paragraph 6, Article 31 paragraph 4, Article 32 paragraph 4, Article 35 paragraph 4, Article 36 paragraph 4 and Article 37 paragraph 3 of the Plant Protection Act ("The Official Gazette", nr. 10/94 and 19/94), the Minister of agriculture and forestry passes

THE REGULATION on the Amendments of the Regulation on Phytosanitary Inspection of Plants and Control of Plant - Protection Products in the National Cross - Boundary Transportation

Article 1

In the Regulation on Phytosanitary Inspection of Plants and Control of Plant - Protection Products in the National Cross - Boundary Transportation ("The Official Gazette" nr. 12/95 and 96/95), in the Article 11 the paragraphs 1 and 3 are declared null and void.

The paragraph 4 became paragraph 1.

Article 2

In the Article 13 the paragraph 2 is declared null and void.

Article 3

In the Annex IV of the Regulation in the items 8 and 12, the words "all countries" are replaced with the word "non-European countries".

Article 4

This Regulation enters into force on the eighth day from the date of its publishing in the "Official Gazette".

The following paragraphs have been deleted from the Regulation on Phytosanitary Inspection of Plants and Control of Plant-Protection Products in the National Cross-Boundary Transportation:

Article 11, paragraph 1

"In addition to general data, the phytosanitary certificate for a consignment of seeds (marked as a the planting or propagating seeds) and of the propagating material, must contain the following additional declaration as well, unless it is otherwise provided by this Regulation: "The plants originate from the plants which have not been infected with quarantine pests of plants. The production was controlled during the growing season by the official plant protection body of the country of origin."

Article 11, paragraph 3

"The additional declaration from paragraph 1 of this Article shall not be required for seed samples of wild plants when they are imported by legal entities engaging in selection and introduction of new species, lines and hybrids, or in protection of plants, or preparation of collections of plants, or maintenance of the genetic material bank."

Article 13, paragraph 2

"When a potato consignment is intended for planting, in addition to the declaration from paragraph 1 of this Article, the phytosanitary certificate must contain the declaration from Article 11 paragraph 1 hereof as well."
