

On basis of Article 49 para 4 of the Law on Customs (Official Gazette of SRM no. 20/90)<sup>1</sup> and Article 45 of the Law on the Government of the Republic of Macedonia (Official Gazette of RM no. 38/90 and 63/94), the Government adopted the following

**DECISION**  
**on Customs Valuation of Goods Subject to Same Tariff Rate**

(Official Gazette no. 67/93)

1. Goods for use in households that citizens of the Republic of Macedonia and foreign citizens residing in the Republic of Macedonia bring in from abroad or receive from abroad, except the goods that are subject to customs privileges pursuant to Articles 28, 29 and 30 of the Law on Customs<sup>2</sup> and the goods for which the Customs Tariff provides a customs tariff “free”, the total value of which does not exceed 2000 DM in countervalue in MKD, shall be subject to same tariff rate of 15%.
2. On the date of effect of this Decision, the Decision on Customs Valuation Subject to Same Tariff Rate (Official Gazette of SFRY no. 46/82, 68/84, 28/86, 13/87, 86/87, 76/88, 45/89 and 5/90 and Official Gazette of RM no. 1/93) shall cease to produce effect in the Republic of Macedonia.
3. This Decision shall come into effect on the date following the date of publication in the “Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia”.
