On Implementation of Pre-shipment Inspection of Imported Goods

Basing on the article 1 letter h) of the Law on the order issuance by the Government no. 1211-XIV dated July 31, 2000 (Monitorul Oficial al Republicii Moldova, 17th August 2000, no. 102-105, art. 749), the Government of the Republic of Moldova O R D E R S:

- 1. To introduce the pre-shipment inspection of goods imported under any customs import regime (inclusively bounded warehouses) and to implement it within 45 days after this Order comes into force.
- 2. To approve the Regulation for Implementation of the Pre-shipment Inspection of goods as specified in Appendix No 1.
- 3. To establish an interagency Committee for implementation and monitoring of the pre-shipment inspection and to approve its regulation as specified in Appendix No 2.
 - In case of dismissal of one of the members of the above mentioned Committee, the functions of the dismissed members shall be performed by nominated persons for these positions.
- 4. The Pre-shipment Inspection shall be performed by the inspection company, nominated according to the Agreement concluded with the Government of the Republic of Moldova.
- 5. From the date of implementation of the Pre-shipment inspection, Customs shall allow to enter into the territory of the Republic of Moldova the imported goods subject to Pre-shipment inspection only at the presentation of the Clean Report of Findings or the Inspection Confirmation, both being issued by the inspection company and confirming the performing of the Pre-shipment Inspection in the country of export.
- 6. Central specialised administrative public bodies and authorities empowered shall approve mandatory requirements for goods and shall adopt the regulations on importation of goods subject to Pre-shipment inspection

according to their competence. They shall provide inspection company and the Department of Technical Supervision, Standardisation and Metrology within 10 days from the commencement into force of this Order the respective information about the regulations in force and within at least 3 days from the approval the regulations adopted afterwards.

7. Ministry of Economy and Reforms, Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Industry and Energy and Department of Technical Supervision, Standardisation and Metrology, in co-operation with other national authorities of the Republic of Moldova and pre-shipment inspection company, within 3 months shall elaborate and present to the Government for the approval the Regulation on the Inspection of Imports of Natural Gases and Electric Power.
