IGA-AGENDA:

The 3rd meeting of the Informal Group on Accessions (IGA) in 2015 took place today, 20 March. The meeting was chaired by the Director of the Accessions Division. IGA Members were briefed on: (i) the Director-General Azevêdo's visit to the accessions and legal exhibition; (ii) state-of-play updates on the Accessions of Kazakhstan and Liberia; (iii) LDCs' accessions; (iv) accession WPs under "maintenance"; and, (v) accession-specific technical assistance and outreach. The Secretariat consulted IGA Members on the updated ECAM: Evolving Calendar of Accession Meetings for 2015 (annexed). H.E. Ambassador Vesa Himanen (Finland), Chairman of the Working Party on the Accession of Kazakhstan, and H.E. Ambassador Joakim Reiter (Sweden), Chairman of the Working Party on the Accession of Liberia, reported to Members on item (ii).

ACCESSIONS AND LEGAL EXHIBITION

The exhibit "The WTO: a rules-based system", at the initiative of Valerie Hughes, Director Legal Affairs Division, had been co-organized with the Accessions Division, the Languages, Documentation and Information Management Division (Graphics, Printing and Archives) and other WTO Divisions: Information and External Relations Division and the Information Technology Solutions Division. The accessions segment of the exhibit was in 3 parts: (i) an information stand, providing a snapshot on how to initiate the WTO accession process, the actual process at a glance, and the architecture of an Accession Package/"Terms of Accession"; (ii) an installation, demonstrating the "Volume Increase of Accession Documents"; and, (iii) a vitrine displaying a sample of Accession Protocols. A 4th component: an interactive WTO Accession Map, demonstrating the expansion of the WTO's membership since 1995, would be added in May/June. The Exhibit could be viewed on the ground floor of the new building. It was a permanent exhibition, as part of the WTO's year-long activities for the 20th Anniversary of the Organization, which would stay in place until December.

ACCESSION OF LIBERIA

H.E. Ambassador Joakim Reiter (Sweden), Chairman of the Working Party on the Accession of Liberia, reported to IGA Members on the state-of-play on the Accession of Liberia.

The accession of Liberia was a "non-problematic" accession. It was a "strong deliverable" for MC10. Liberia's Negotiating Team, led by the Chief Negotiator, Minister Addy, had been in Geneva for an extended period, returning as necessary, to develop the Draft Working Party Report (DWPR). The DWPR was progressing, substantively and steadily. Monrovia had just submitted its revised Agriculture Supporting Tables (AGSTs). There had been progress on bilateral market access negotiations with six interested Members, at the closure of the established timeline. The objective remained to have the Draft Accession Package emerge before the Summer Break. The next cycle of Working Party meetings was envisaged for late April / early May 2015. Members requested ample time to review Monrovia's responses to their questions/requests before the WP meeting was convened. Ambassador Reiter thanked Members for their pragmatism, encouragement and support and paid tribute to DG Azevêdo's leadership on the accession of Liberia. He remained in steady coordination with Minister Axel Addy, the Chief Negotiator on the Accession of Liberia and Members to focus on the substance of Liberia's accession.

ACCESSION OF KAZAKHSTAN

H.E. Ambassador Vesa Himanen (Finland), Chairman of the Working Party on the Accession of Kazakhstan, briefed IGA Members on the state-of-play on the accession of Kazakhstan.

The accession of Kazakhstan was at the threshold of conclusion. The Draft Accession Package was being finalized. On 17 March 2015, the Secretariat had circulated the 5th revision of the Draft Goods Schedule to the 29 Signatory Members and the Russian Federation. The Technical Verification Meeting was scheduled for 31 March. The Draft Services Schedule, which had already been verified, was stabilized and, had been re-

circulated, in its final form, on 17 March. The Draft Working Party Report (DWPR) was expected to emerge, shortly, as soon as a few remaining questions were resolved. The next cycle of meetings, which would comprise informal, plurilateral and the Working Party Meeting, was envisaged for late April / early May. He urged Members and Kazakhstan to show flexibility to resolve the remaining issues, as soon as possible.

LDCs' ACCESSIONS

<u>Afghanistan</u>: Together with Liberia, this LDC accession was a deliverable in 2015. The Draft Accession Package, circulated in March 2014, was stable. Kabul would contact the Secretariat regarding the date for the next WP meeting. At this time, Secretariat was updating, together with Kabul, some time-sensitive parts of the documents and Legislative Action Plan (LAP).

<u>Comoros</u>: Comoros was working on the inputs for its Working Party.

Other LDCs' Accessions were currently inactive.

CONCLUDED ACCESSIONS

<u>Seychelles</u>: The Government of Seychelles had invited the WP Chairperson, Mme Hilda Al Hinai, and the WTO Secretariat for an activity to facilitate the ratification of Seychelles' Accession Protocol and explain Seychelles' terms of WTO membership and its benefits. The activity was scheduled from 23 to 25 March.

MAINTENANCE WORK

<u>Azerbaijan</u>: The last cycle of meetings on the Accession of Azerbaijan, which comprised the Agriculture Plurilateral and the WP meeting, had taken place on 5 and 6 March. Members had been invited to submit their written questions/answers by 15 April.
