Patrick Low is a Geneva-based consultant. He was an Adjunct Professor at the University of Hong Kong (2016-19), and Vice-President for Research at the Hong Kong-based Fung Global Institute (2013-2015). He worked at the secretariat of the World Trade Organization from 1995 and was Chief Economist from 1997 to 2013. During much of this period he also taught trade policy and trade and climate change as an Adjunct Professor at the Graduate Institute in Geneva. He worked in the research complex at the World Bank from 1990 to 1994, having taught at the Colegio de México from 1987 to 1990. He was with the GATT Secretariat from 1980 to 1987. He holds a PhD in economics and has published widely on trade matters.
