

**DECREE OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION NO. 855 OF JULY 22, 2005 ON THE  
FEDERAL AGENCY FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF SPECIAL ECONOMIC ZONES (with the  
Amendments and Additions of September 24, 2007)**

In accordance with Article 112 of the Constitution of the Russian Federation and for the purpose of implementing the Federal Law on Special Economic Zones in the Russian Federation I hereby resolve:

**1.** That a Federal Agency for the Management of Special Economic Zones be set up under the Ministry of Economic Development and Trade of the Russian Federation.

**2.** That the Government of the Russian Federation complete the following within three months:  
approving regulations on the Federal Agency for the Management of Special Economic Zones;  
approving a maximum limit on the number of members of the central staff and of the territorial bodies of the Federal Agency for the Management of Special Economic Zones as well as the payroll fund of the employees thereof;

arranging for resolving the financial, organisational and other matters relating to the implementation of the present Decree;

bringing its acts in line with the present Decree.

**3.** Abrogated.

**4.** The present Decree shall enter into force as of the date of the signing thereof.
