RESOLUTION

of 25 December 2002, No. 1986

Kiev

On Procedure for Customs Inspection, Clearance, and Admission Across the Customs Border of Ukraine of Goods in Respect to the Transfer of Which Restrictions Have Been Introduced

As amended by the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine
of 18 January 2003, No. 92

In Accordance with Article 97 of the Customs Code of Ukraine, the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine hereby **RESOLVES**:

1. To establish that customs inspection, clearance, and admission across the customs border of Ukraine of goods in respect to the transfer of which restrictions have been introduced, shall be conducted by customs bodies on the basis of permission issued by the competent state authority vested with the appropriate supervisory functions, and in accordance with the standard operational sequences established for the performance of customs inspection of automotive, water, rail, and air transport facilities of carriers at the points of crossing of the state border of Ukraine, following the completion of statutory other inspection procedures (sanitary-epidemiological, veterinary, phyto-sanitary, radiological, ecological, and pertaining to movement of cultural valuables) as required for the good concerned.

In the absence of such permission from the competent state authority vested with the appropriate supervisory functions, or in the event of presentation of a permit not in conformance with the approved form, the customs body concerned shall furnish to the interested persons a written notice indicating the reasons for the refusal and containing an exhaustive elucidation of requirements the compliance with which will make possible the performance of customs clearance and admission across the customs border of Ukraine of goods in respect to the transfer of which restrictions have been introduced.

2. This Resolution shall come into force on January 1, 2004.
