## STATEMENT by OSMAN OMER ELSHARIF THE MINISTER OF TRADE

## **BALI, INDONESIA 3 - 5 DECEMBER 2013**

Mr. Chairman,

Honourable Ministers, Delegates, Ladies and Gentlemen

At the outset, let me express my sincere gratitude to the Government of Indonesia for hosting this conference and the excellent facilities provided to us since our arrival in beautiful Bali. I sincerely congratulate Mr. Roberto Azevêdo on his appointment as Director General of the WTO.

Sudan has undertaken extensive reforms aiming at liberalizing its economy and foreign trade regime. The main objective of the reforms is to facilitate the integration of Sudan into the multilateral trading system and to bring our

legal and institutional framework in line with the WTO regime.

In recent years, Sudan has been making genuine efforts to resume its accession to the WTO which has been on hold since 2004.

Sudan remains ready and willing to engage constructively with the WTO to reactivate the accession process in 2014. In this regard, we request the Working Party members to support us.

Sudan congratulates Yemen on its accession to WTO and looks forward to benefit from its experience. Indeed accession of LDCs such as Yemen, Sudan and Ethiopia can contribute to the universality of the WTO.

world and be a testimony of the credibility of the WTO.
