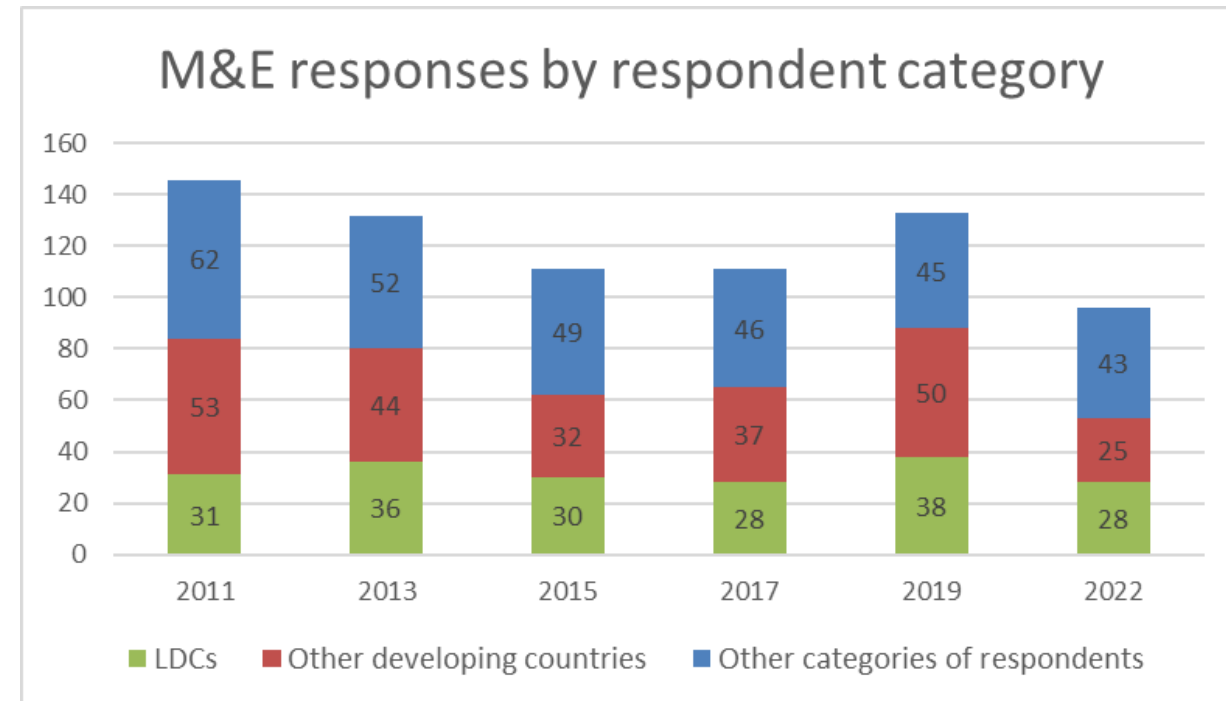
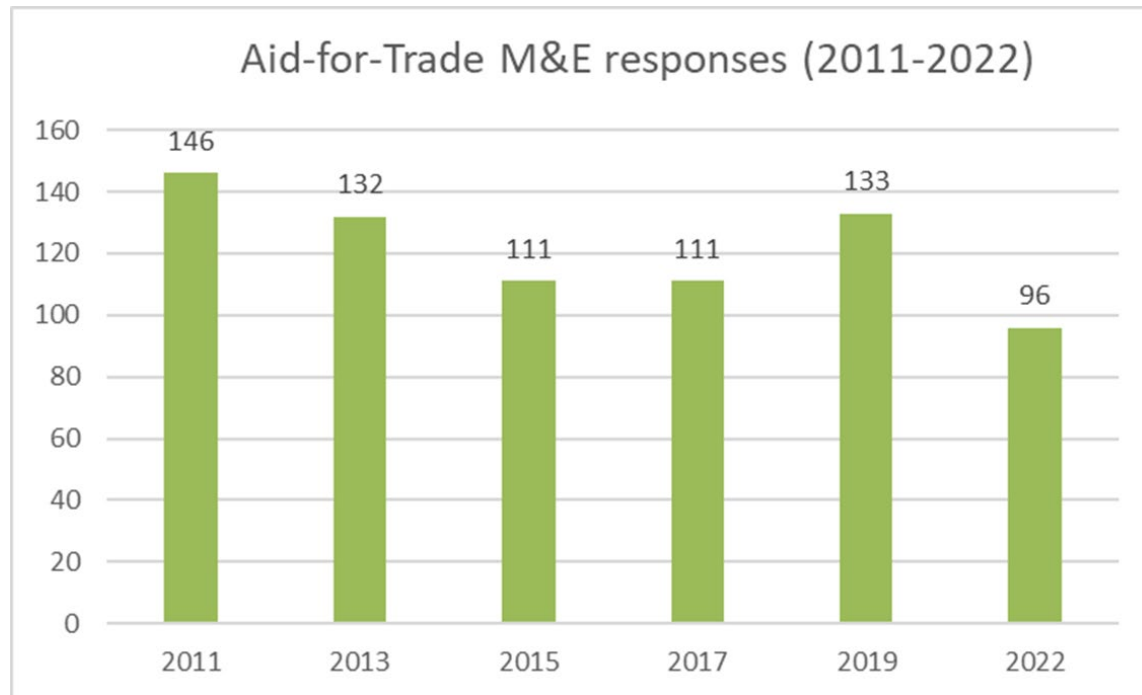
- Work programme 2020-21: "Empowering connected, sustainable trade"

Headline messages

- Trade priorities remain prominent in development strategies despite changes made due to COVID-19 pandemic
- Good evidence of growing prioritization and mainstreaming of the three themes of empowerment, connectivity and sustainability
- Most developing country respondents see Aid for Trade as more important than before, against the backdrop of the pandemic and climate change
