Session Description

Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs) play a major role in Emerging Markets and Developing Economies (EMDEs) - driving economic growth, creating employment opportunities, and supporting the creation of a vibrant local economy. At the same time, SMEs are disproportionately vulnerable to climate-related risks and shocks.

SMEs play a vital role in a just transition that delivers equitable human and economic development. Recognizing these challenges and opportunities, particularly across emerging markets and developing economies (EMDEs), the COP29 High-Level Champion (HLC), Nigar Arparadai, launched the "Climate-Proofing SMEs" campaign to improve SMEs' awareness of and access to relevant capacity building measures and opportunities to access finance - so they too can thrive in the green transition.

This roundtable will bring together organisations providing support to SMEs in EMDEs through the COP29 Climate-Proofing SMEs campaign, alongside SMEs and other organisation in EMDEs to share experience-based insights and a way forward on the role of partnerships in enabling access to finance and support for SMEs. The objectives of this session are:

- 1. To explore key barriers and opportunities in enabling access to finance for SMEs through coordinated action /partnerships
- 2. Showcasing the support and resources offered by key global actors for scaling access for finance for SMEs (Including the role of last mile financial service providers)
- 3. Aligning strategic priorities and activities of key actors in the SME ecosystem to effectively scale access to finance for SME in EMDEs
