

Implementation 2021-2022: Work Programme Priorities


- Establishing permanent new Department in OIE
 - Head of department, technical coordinator, scientific officer, data analysts
- Developing further prototypes, considering lessons learnt from previous ones
- Improving the Standards Monitoring Framework: Repeatable methodology
 - Identifying impactful Indicators and their link to International Standards
 - Establishing connection with Global Strategies
 e.g. AMR Strategy, Indicator: No. of countries using
 antibiotics for growth promotion
 e.g. PPR Strategy, Indicator: No. of countries with National
 PPR Control Programme officially recognised by the OIE/




