






## ePing: steady increase in number of registrations



## **Ongoing efforts to enhance system**



### Complementary factors for drawing maximum benefits from transparency framework and online tools

- Level of compliance with notification obligations
- Quality of information in notifications
- Active engagement/empowerment of Enquiry Points
- Awareness/engagement from the private sector
- Effective national coordination mechanism
- Language/Technical capacity to assess/meet requirements
- Awareness of rights and obligations under SPS/TBT Agreements
- Participation in WTO SPS/TBT Committees



- ePing can serve as a practical tool to manage notifications, facilitate dialogue among stakeholders
- complementary efforts needed at national level to maximize benefits
- ongoing resources needed to maintain/improve system and provide capacity building and outreach
