There is a constant dialogue among the main regulators, international trade authorities and the TBT National Notification Authority


and many opportunities for it:

- whenever necessary for clarifying notification drafts





Flow from main regulators to TBT and SPS notification authorities and to WTO







Most TBT notifications are for regulations issued by:

- ANVISA Brazilian Health Regulatory Agency
- MAPA Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Food Supply
- INMETRO Natl. Inst. of Metrology, Quality and Technology

Around 160 notifications per year:

37% ANVISA

34% MAPA

23% INMETRO

6% other regulators





SPS notifications are for measures issued by:

- ANVISA Brazilian Health Regulatory Agency
- MAPA Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Food Supply

Around 160 notifications per year:

80% ANVISA 20% MAPA

> 70% pesticides 15% territory protection (plants)





Regulators notify all technical regulations that have impact on trade, including less trade restrictive measures and those based on international standards, going beyond what is prescribed in both Agreements.

That is enhanced transparency!

And the number of "double" notifications (TBT and SPS) have increased over the past year.


