

WHO, WIPO, WTO Workshop on Innovation in, and Access to, COVID-19 Technologies:

Accessing and Using Information Resources for the Pandemic Response

Roger Kampf is from Hamburg, Germany. He joined the World Trade Organization in May 2004 and works as Counsellor in the Intellectual Property, Government Procurement and Competition Division. Mr Kampf is responsible for the Secretariat's work in the area of TRIPS and public health and IP enforcement. He also oversees the Division's technical assistance activities in relation to intellectual property. From 2016 to 2018, Mr Kampf has been the Secretary of the Council for TRIPS.

From 1998 to 2004, Mr. Kampf worked for the European Commission at its headquarters in Brussels and at the permanent representation in Geneva, where he was responsible for intellectual property issues in WTO and WIPO, as well as for government procurement. Prior to this, he was involved in negotiations on financial services under the GATS Agreement, and also worked as an assistant in public law and European Communities law at the University of Hamburg. Mr. Kampf holds a law degree from the University of Hamburg and a degree in public administration from the Ecole Nationale d'Administration in Paris. He has published on various aspects of EC and WTO law.
