## WTO Membership statistics on female leadership (2023)

%

- 36% of WTO Ambassadors are female
- 19% of Ministers in charge of WTO affairs are female
- 4 women chairs of the General Council since 1995
- 23% of WTO bodies are chaired by women (includes the General Council Chair)
- 17% of the accession working parties are chaired by women

## Women's participation in the WTO dispute settlement system

Bodies / Positions	Data
Panellists	Between 1 January 2022 and October 2023, 10 panels have been composed. Out of the 30 panellists appointed during this period, 40% were women.
WTO Indicative List of governmental and non-governmental panellists	Out of 464 names on the WTO Indicative List of governmental and non-governmental panellists, 22% are women and 78% are men.
Arbitrations pursuant to Article 22.6 of the DSU	No arbitrator was composed between 2022 and 2023.



Female leadership in National Trade Facilitation Committees (NTFCs)

- On average, 37% of NTFCs' members are women
- 40% of NTFCs are chaired or co-chaired by women

### WTO Secretariat Statistics on female leadership and women in management positions

Data compilation from gender equality internal audit 2022 and HR data from 2023

- 12% women in leadership, decision making and management roles. Notes: Average grades 9 to 12 (includes directors, Deputy Director-Generals and Director-General)
- 14% of women in middle management levels. Note: Average, grades 7 to 8

Building female leadership: the link with trade policy

#### 1. Some data

 About 6% of all FTAs/RTAs notified to the WTO include a provision on female leadership and access to decision-making positions Policies

- About 2% include leadership in science, technology and innovation
- 1 mention in national trade policies

Building female leadership: the link with trade policy

- 2. Focus of provisions contained in FTAs/RTAs
- Develop female leadership through training and experience sharing
- Foster female leadership networks in business and trade
- Promote and facilitate equal participation of men and women in decision-making positions and in positions of authority.
