

Some history



Some data

- 652 government officials trained (since 2018)
 - not counting WTO's contributions to other training programmes (UNCTAD, APEC, FAO, ALADI, etc.)

%

- Success rates (2023-2024)
 - Over 75% considered the course excellent
 - About 70% considered that the course has substantially enhanced their skills and knowledge
 - <u>All</u> participants would recommend it to other colleagues

Going beyond the figures: a qualitative approach



- Focussing more on qualitative outcomes
- Contribution to members' trade policy making activities
- Using various WTO gender-responsive trade policy making tools and exercises
- Creation of an alumni network
