

Figure 1. Upgrading & Female Intensity in Costa Rica and the Dominican Republic Medical Devices GVC




- Female intensity in MDs higher than in EPZ, manufacturing and labor market
- Held steady/increased with upgrading into more sophisticated products
- Good quality jobs > Permanent contracts, benefits and relatively high wages
